Guidelines on spectators at games.

COVID-19 Saturday 19th & Sunday 20th Sept.

Following the joint statement issued from Northumberland & Durham FA on Friday 18th September 2020, Northumberland Football Leagues would like to echo the sentiments from both counties and ask everyone to follow all COVID-19 guidelines and ensure football can continue to be played within the region.

Given the new measures introduced by the local authorities and restrictions currently in place, we would ask the following for spectators attending ALL youth football, including central venues and home & away games) from this weekend

- Strictly 1 adult per player at ALL games
- Spectators to wear face coverings at all times were possible
- Spectators to stand a minimum of 1mtr apart at all times
- No shouting
- Personal hand sanitizer to be carried
- DO NOT attend if you or you child have any COVID-19 symptoms
- Please ensure you follow all venue/facility COVID-19 guidelines in addition to the above.
- Always follow and respect the venue/facility and their rules

These guidelines have been issued to ensure the region can continue to enjoy playing football in a safe environment. Northumberland Football leagues respectfully ask that all involved with the game follow the guidelines.
